

The faculty members Mr. A. Jayarami Reddy, Mrs. V. V. Vandana Mrs. K.V.R. Rajeswari, Dr. N. Prathibha, Dr. M. Thabitha, Mr. Ravi Kumar and Pharm D students of NSS and IPA involved in this programme. All the participants divided themselves into six teams with members of ten each worked in six villages for six consecutive weeks on Saturdays and Sundays along with one staff coordinator during 23 rd June – 31 st July. They selected Unguturu, Garapadu, Ponukumadu, Nagavarappadu, Tuttagunta and Vennuthala Villages in Unguturu Mandal, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh.

A weekly action plan was scheduled which include cleaning of the roads, awareness programmes on Swachh Bharat themes like Sanitation, Solid Waste Management, general and health related issues. IPA student Volunteers have also conducted health camps and distributed free medicines from the institution's Jan Aushadhi medical store to the villagers. They worked together with the local village sarpanches, government officers, government school teachers and anganwadi personnel. This programme enlightened the villagers on importance of sanitation and proper ways to maintain it for good health.
