


Figure 2 Skit Competition (14-08-2019)



Rules for Shotput

- > Once the athlete's name is called, they have 60 seconds to release the shot
- ➤ The shot must be placed close to the neck and resting on the shoulder, while keeping it in that position the entire time until it is released. No padding or extra equipment is necessary
- > The shot must be released above the height of the shoulder with one hand
- > The athlete is permitted to touch the inside surface of the stop board; however, neither the top nor the outside of the circle or stop board can be touched or passed
- The shot is required to land within the legal sector (34.92°)
- > The competitor must exit the circle from the back

Rules for Discus Throw

- > The discus can only be thrown by an athlete when he or she will stand inside a circle which has a diameter of 2.5m.
- > During the course of throw, the athletes are prohibited from touching the top of the rim. However, they can touch the inner part of the rim.
- > An athlete cannot touch the ground beyond the circle.
- > If the athlete leaves the circle before the landing of the disc on the ground, then it will be considered as a foul throw.
- > There is particular boundary of landing of the disc. If the disc lands outside that zone then that throw is considered invalid.

Rules for Running Competition

- > Athlete should run in designated lanes and cannot cross lanes, throughout the race.
- Athlete shouldn't step on white lines that mark their lanes throughout the race.
- > Before giving the 'set' command, athletes cannot touch the other side of the start line with their hands or feet.
- > Athletes should not obstruct other athletes during the race.
- > If an athlete is obstructed, the referee may order the race to be held again, or he may ask the athlete to take part in the next round.
- > Athletes may leave the track voluntarily before the race ends, but they cannot come back to the track else they will be disqualified.



Rules for Essay Writing and News Writing Competition

- > The length of the essay should not be more than 1500 words.
- > The language should be in English only
- > Written on an A4 Sheet
- > Students will have to bring their own stationary.
- > It should include Name of the Participant, Year, Section and Roll number

Rules for Debate Competition

- > There will be maximum two teams from each institute comprising of two members (each in 1 team) one speaking For the Motion and the other Against the Motion.
- ➤ Each speaker will be allowed to express his or her views for 3+1 minutes followed by an interjection from the audience. No cross questioning is allowed.
- ➤ The speaker will be evaluated on the criteria of content, diction, eloquence, body language and confidence level.

Rules for Pick and speak Competition

- > The speech may not exceed 5 minutes in duration. The time limit will be strictly enforced.
- Points will be awarded based on the following criteria:

a. CONTENT

- Greeting & Introduction of the subject
- Exposition of the main theme.
- Conclusion

b. SPEAKING PRESENTATION

- Memorization (evaluated by pauses and amount of referring to index cards)
- Verbal Clarity (Annunciation and pronunciation of words, voice strength and projection)
- Presentation/Speaking Style (Mannerisms, Audience contact and voice modulation, ability to keep the audience engaged by their speaking style)

Rules for Painting Competition

- Drawing / painting must be on paper of A3 size (297 x 420 mm) or A2 size (420 x 594 mm).
- Acceptable tools of drawing / painting include pencil, crayon, water colour, oil paint, computer drawing, etc. Photographs, wires, and other 3D objects are not acceptable. The completed artwork must be on a flat piece of paper.
- > It should include Name of the Participant, Year, Section and Roll number
- > The theme should be the main focus of the poster.






Figure 3 Solo Dance Competition (Dt:06-11-2019)




Figure 1 Speech by the Chief Guest on the occasion of the Freshers Day(31-12-2019)




Figure 3 Face Painting(10-01-2020)




Fig 2Tribute to National Flag (26-01-2020)

Rules for Throw Ball Competition

Each team shall consist of factive players and 5 substitutes

- Any ball to be released should be released from above the shoulder/Shoulder line only
- > The ball has to be caught with the both hands and returned in one hand only
- > Service ball should not touch the net
- Double touch is not allowed for receiving the ball
- The ball should be served after the whistle and within 5 seconds
- > Ball should be served only from the service zone and without crossing the end line
- Any ball falling on the box line or in the dead zone is a foul
- During catching or releasing ball body touch is not allowed.

Rules for Kabaddi Competition

- Each team shall consist of no more than 12 players with only 7 taking to the field at any one time.
- The duration of the match is two halves of 20 minutes with a half time break of 5
- > At the start of a Kabaddi match, there is a coin toss with the winner having the choice as to whether to have the first raid or not. In the second half of the match, the team that did not raid first shall begin the second half with a raid.
- To win a point when raiding, the raider must take a breath and run into the opposition's half and tag one or more members of the opposing team and then return to their own half of the pitch before inhaling again.
- To prove that another breath hasn't been taken, the rider must continue to repeatedly yell the word 'Kabaddi'. Failure to do this, even for just a moment means that the rider must return to their own side of the court without points and the opposite team is awarded a point for a successful defence play.
- The team being raided is defending, and the players must prevent the raiders from tagging them and returning back over the halfway line. Whilst in defence, a team may score a point by successfully preventing the raider returning to their own half after tagging them. Raiders may only be grabbed by their limbs or torso, not by their hair, clothes or anywhere else, and defenders are not permitted to cross the centre line.
- > Each team will take turns in raiding and defending. Following halftime, the two teams switch sides of the court and the team who defended first in the first half begin the second half by raiding.
- The game continues in this way until the time is up, the team with the most points at the end of the match is declared the winner.

Rules for Kho-Kho Competition

- > The running or chasing side is decided by the toss.
- A team consists of 12 players in which two teams of 9 playing members play against each other alternately in four turns or quarters of 9 minute each.
- > 'Chaser 'team takes a sitting position in the cross lanes with opposite back in 8 squares and one player stands near the pole.
- > Runner tram sends players for running. While other runners will wait for their turn in entry zone area
- > Chaser team attempts to catch the running players while passing on Kho from one player to another.
- Chaser player can only move in one direction without crossing the central lane
 The points are awarded by the depal touch of chaser player to the running players

Rules for Tennikoit Competition

- > Players have to catch Koit ring with only one hand and throw it properly.
- > The Koit Ring be thrown with the same hand it has been caught and without wobbling.
- > Also, players are not allowed to step into the area under the Net which is called as dead Court.
- Players are not allowed to walk and run with the ring.
- > Tennikoit is played in three (3) sets of games and each set consists of twenty-one (21) points.
- > In addition to this, to win the match players have to win at least two (2) Sets of the game.
- Also, to win a Set player have to make twenty-one (21) points with at least two (2) points lead against opponent. For example: 'Player A' will win the Set if he/she scores twenty-one (21) points while his/her opponent 'Player B' is at nineteen (19) points.
- > If Both player A and player B scores twenty (20) points each, then that player who scores twenty-two (22) will be awarded as winner of the set.
- > Also, in this game each player has to take five (5) services continuously, regardless of the fact that player lost or wins the point.
- In addition, Players have to serve the Koit ring over the Net diagonally into the opponent court.

Rules for Carrom Competition

Players get the three chances in their first turn to "break". In those particular chances, it does not matter whether the striker hit the carrom men or not. However, when a player pockets the chosen colour carrom or queen, then he is provided with a second chance. But if he/she commits a foul or is not able to pocket any pieces, then the chance of strike will be passed to another end.

Rules for Group Singing Competition: -

- Maximum 3-6 singers in a group.
- The group songs should be in Telugu, English or Hindi.
- Maximum time allowed for the group song is 10 minutes

Solo Dance - Rules and Regulations

- Time limit is 2-3 minutes. Negative points for exceeding the time limit.
- The participants will be judged on their costumes, visual presentation and dance form.
- There is no particular theme.
- Participants should get their own props. All props must be specified to the event coordinator.






Figure 2 Group Dance (17-02-2020)






Figure 7 Kabaddi Competition (19-02-2020)




Figure 10 Carrom Competition (22-02-2020)





Rules for Throw Ball Competition

- Each team shall consist of 7 active players and 5 substitutes
- Any ball to be released should be released from above the shoulder/Shoulder line only
- The ball has to be caught with the both hands and returned in one hand only
- > Service ball should not touch the net
- > Double touch is not allowed for receiving the ball
- > The ball should be served after the whistle and within 5 seconds
- > Ball should be served only from the service zone and without crossing the end line
- Any ball falling on the box line or in the dead zone is a foul
- During catching or releasing ball body touch is not allowed.

Rules for Kabaddi Competition

- ➤ Each team shall consist of no more than 12 players with only 7 taking to the field at any one time.
- > The duration of the match is two halves of 20 minutes with a half time break of 5 minutes.
- At the start of a Kabaddi match, there is a coin toss with the winner having the choice as to whether to have the first raid or not. In the second half of the match, the team that did not raid first shall begin the second half with a raid.

- > To win a point when raiding, the raider must take a breath and run into the opposition's half and tag one or more members of the opposing team and then return to their own half of the pitch before inhaling again.
- > To prove that another breath hasn't been taken, the rider must continue to repeatedly yell the word 'Kabaddi'. Failure to do this, even for just a moment means that the rider must return to their own side of the court without points and the opposite team is awarded a point for a successful defence play.
- The team being raided is defending, and the players must prevent the raiders from tagging them and returning back over the halfway line. Whilst in defence, a team may score a point by successfully preventing the raider returning to their own half after tagging them. Raiders may only be grabbed by their limbs or torso, not by their hair, clothes or anywhere else, and defenders are not permitted to cross the centre line.
- > Each team will take turns in raiding and defending. Following halftime, the two teams switch sides of the court and the team who defended first in the first half begin the second half by raiding.
- > The game continues in this way until the time is up, the team with the most points at the end of the match is declared the winner.




Figure 3 Prize Distribution by the Chief Guest


