and cracks and smoothing out the internal walls and as a protective barrier against external invaders like snakes, lizards, and so forth, or against weathering threats like wind and rain. Bees gather propolis from different plants, in the temperate climate zone mainly from poplar. Current antimicrobial applications of propolis include formulations for cold syndrome (upper respiratory tract infections, common cold, and flu-like infections), wound healing, treatment of burns, acne, herpes simplex and genitalis, and neurodermatitis. By the end of the session students gained the knowledge about various properties of propolis.

On day two, Dr. P. Selvam delivered his talk on **Recent Advances in “Novel Therapeutic Approaches in Treatment of SARSCOV-2/COVID 2019”**. To date, there is no licensed treatment or approved vaccine to combat the coronavirus disease of 2019 (COVID-19), and the number of new cases and mortality multiplies every day. Therefore, it is essential to develop an effective treatment strategy to control the virus spread and prevent the disease. Although it seems that antiviral drugs are effective in improving clinical manifestation, there is no definite treatment protocol. Lymphocytopenia, excessive inflammation, and cytokine storm followed by acute respiratory distress syndrome are still unsolved issues causing the severity of this disease. Therefore, immune response modulation and inflammation management can be considered as an essential step. There is no doubt that more studies are required to clarify immunopathogenesis and immune response; however, new therapeutic approaches including mesenchymal stromal cell and immune cell therapy showed inspiring results. By the end of the session students and faculty gained knowledge about the signs, symptoms and different approaches to treat covid-19.

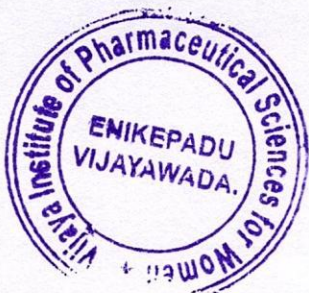

Dr. N. Sridevi in which she mainly focused on the concepts of molecular biology and general philosophy of science. Her talk concentrated on Research in the area of Systems and on Synthetic Biology Approaches to build microbial genomes which was followed by a brain storming session. After the lunch break, Dr. N. Sridevi's lecture was about research in the area of enzyme nanoparticles for biosensor applications. She discussed the highlights of accelerator based research and its significance over conventional techniques. Dr. N. Sridevi also covered the topics of proteomics and their latest findings on Diabetes and Alzheimers. Huge discussion followed thereafter. This marked the end of the first day programme.

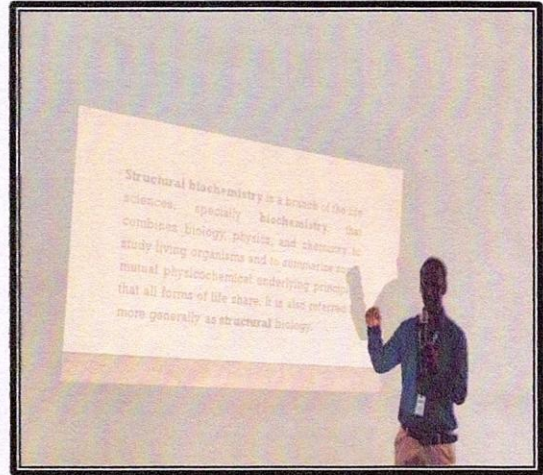
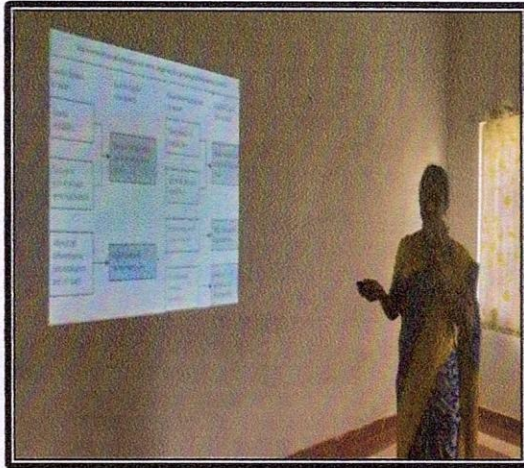
