
# ETV PLUS STUDENT NO 1






Figure 4 Sankranthi Celebrations-Rangoli, Mehendi, Ikebana and Face Painting Competitions


### Dance




Figure 14 Shot Put




Figure 21 Kabaddi




Figure 23 Tug of War


