The celebration came to an end by singing the National Anthem. The students dispersed after enjoying the day filled with happiness and joy knowing about each other and building up new bonds.

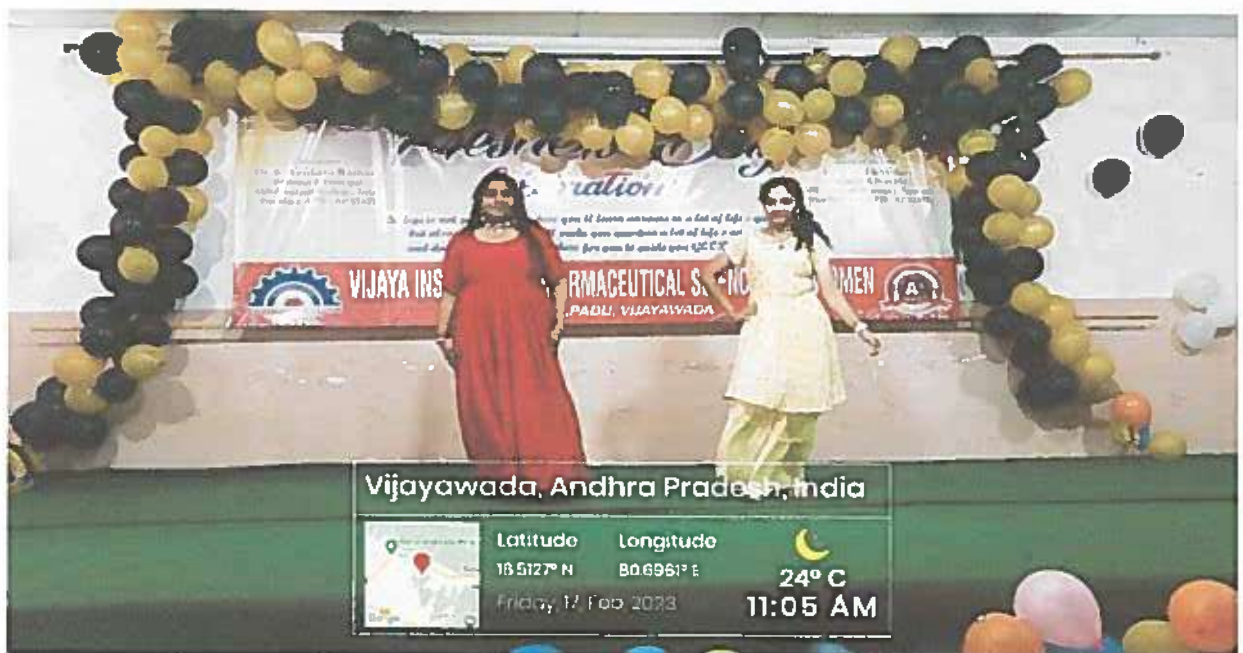

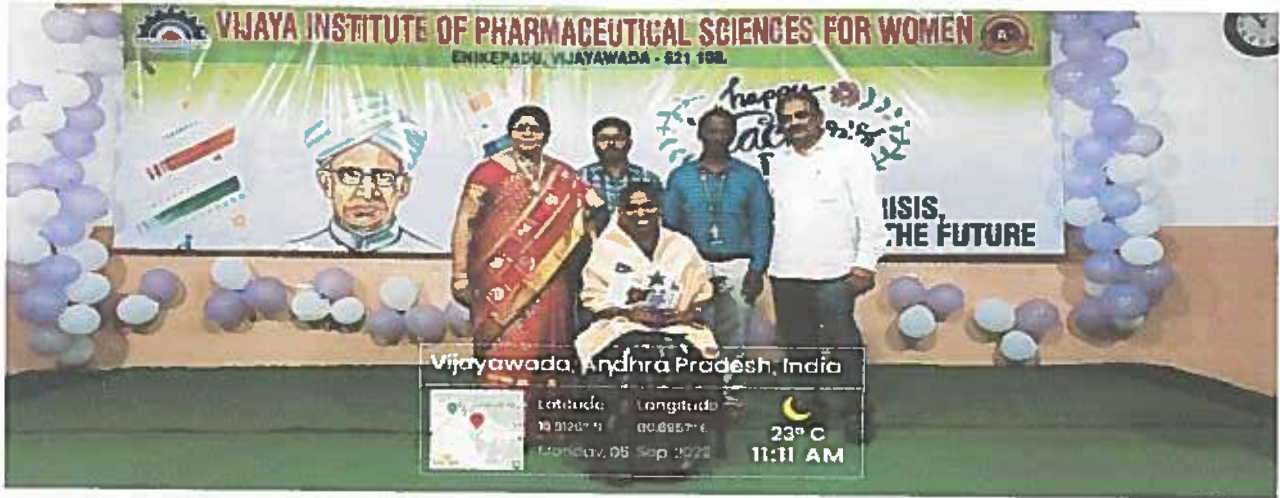
