This proprietary information is vital to these companies' survival, and among their most valuable corporate assets. Each is protected as a trade secret. While patent law offers strong protections for proprietary inventions, obtaining a patent requires establishing that the invention is novel, non-obvious, and patent-eligible. It also requires disclosure of the invention itself in the patent application. And while patents last for twenty years, they do not last forever. By contrast, trade secrecy provides another avenue to protecting a company's IP that allows the inventions to be kept secret and potentially protected forever. The talk provided special insights into Trade Secrets followed by various industries across the globe. Followed by the technical sessions a Q and A session was conducted. 153 participants attended the seminar and Principal, Prof. K. 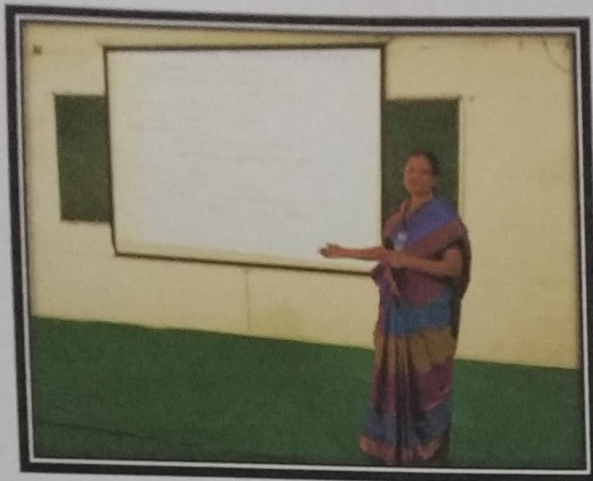
**Dr. A. Padmaja** concentrated on “**Dissertation Writing**”, A dissertation is an extended piece of writing of between ten and twenty thousand words on a topic set by a department or one chosen by the student him or herself. It is usually divided into chapters and may contain headings and sub-headings, and these are sometimes (though not always) numbered as in a report. Dissertations answer a particular research question and can either report on an empirical study or on a literature-based study. Although the purpose of a dissertation is to answer the question, the process is more important than the actual findings. Even if you produce no usable data whatsoever, you can still get a first in your dissertation - as long as you can show that you have learned about the research process and are able to analyse it and understand why you were unable to answer the question as successfully as you may have wished. From the talk students gained knowledge about how to write an effective research proposal and thesis.

Post tea break, **Dr. G. Chenchamma**, delivered her lecture on **Research Methodology: Experimental Design**. An experiment is a method of data collection designed to test hypotheses under controlled conditions. Several kinds of experimental designs exist. In general, designs that are **true experiments** contain three key features: independent and dependent variables, pretesting and post testing, and experimental and control groups. In a true experiment, the effect of an intervention is tested by comparing two groups. One group is exposed to the intervention (the experimental group, also known as the treatment group) and the other is not exposed to the intervention (the control group). By the end of the session students gained knowledge about different experimental designs that can be followed while pursuing research, before arriving at a hypothesis. The Q and A session cleared the doubts of students and faculty research scholars, following which vote of thanks was given by Mrs. V. Vandana. An overwhelming response was obtained as 145 participants attended the seminar.

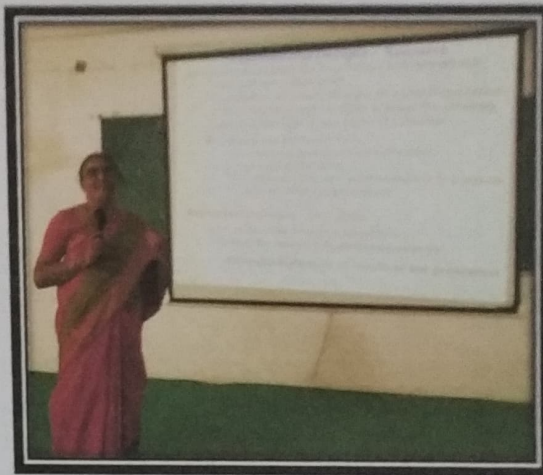

barriers to innovation and creativity, QbD is being widely promoted by Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and International Conference on Harmonization (ICH).

Further, Mr. Ramesh Adepu, Manager, Aizant Drug Research Solutions Pvt Ltd, Hyderabad delivered a talk on **Recent Trends in Bio-analytical Techniques**. The major bioanalytical role is method development, method validation, and sample analysis. Every step in the method must be investigated to decide the extent to which environment, matrix, or procedural variables can interfere the estimation of analyte in the matrix from the time of set up to the time of analysis. Techniques such as high pressure liquid chromatography (HPLC) and liquid chromatography coupled with double mass spectrometry (LCMS-MS) can be used for the bioanalysis of drugs in body. Each of the instruments has its own merits and demerits. Chromatographic methods are HPLC and gas chromatography have been mainly used for the bioanalysis of small/ large molecules, with LC/MS/MS. Linearity, accuracy, precision, selectivity, sensitivity, reproducibility, and stability are some of the regularly used parameters. By the end of the session delegates gained knowledge about the latest techniques that are used to estimate various biological fluids.

Post lunch, delegates presented their scientific works and guests evaluated the posters and prizes were distributed. In the valedictory session, **Sri Paruchuri Rambabu**, Asst. Director, Drug Control Administration, Vijayawada addressed the delegates as the Chief Guest. An overwhelming response was obtained and 207 participants attended the seminar including research scholars, PG, UG students, and teaching staff.

### ABOUT THE SEMINAR :

The QbD in pharmaceutical product development is now a thrust area for the regulatory authorities and the pharmaceutical industry. QbD implementation lead to a successful product development, subsequent prompt regulatory approval, reduce exhaustive validation burden and significantly reduce post-approval changes. The key elements of QbD viz., target product quality profile, critical quality attributes, risk assessments, design space, control strategy, product lifecycle management and continual improvement are discussed to understand the performance of dosage forms within design space. Design of experiments, risk assessment tools and process analytical technology are also discussed for their role in QbD.
