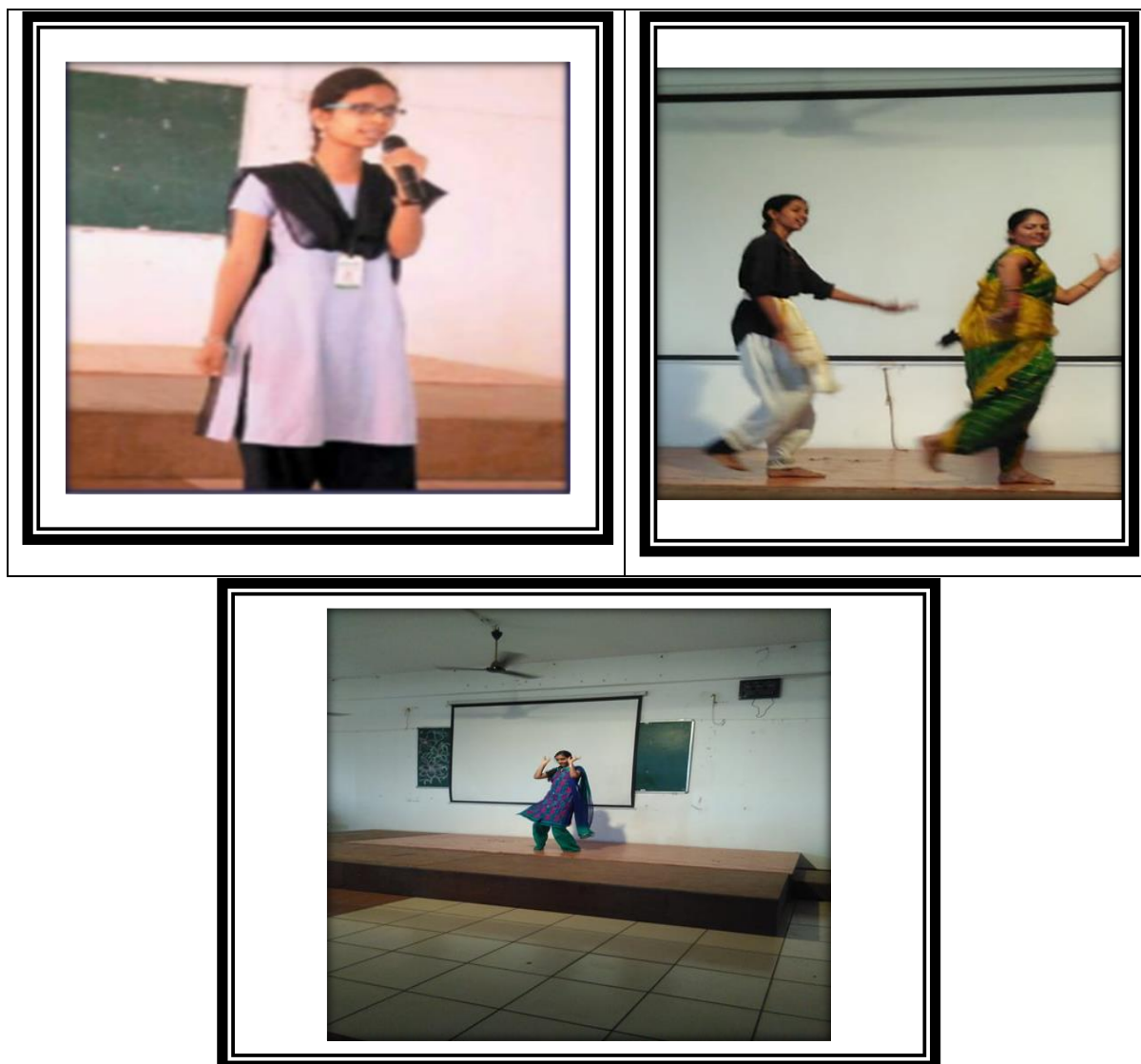


Figure 15 Solo Singing, Group Dance and Solo Dance Competitions
