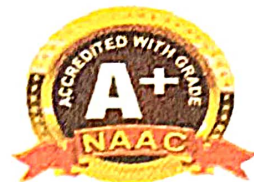

The Day 1 scientific session started with a talk on "The Sex Independent Angle of Type – II Diabetes" by **Dr. Terry G Ramnanan Singh**, Research officer, South-West Regional Health Authority (SWRHA), San Fernando, Trinidad & Tobago, West Indies. It was hypothesised that the mean angle index of patients with type 2 diabetes would be higher than the mean angle index of patients without type 2 diabetes.

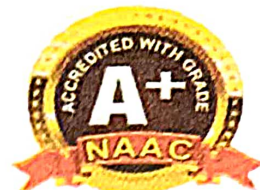

manganese, cadmium, and arsenic, and also pesticides and metal-based nanoparticles, have been implicated in neural diseases. He concluded his talk saying that neurological dysfunction has received global consideration owing to their global occurrence. The scientific session was chaired by Dr M Vani, Professor, dept. of Pharmacognosy & Phytochemistry, VIPW. Delegates interacted with the speaker with questionaire and solutions were addressed to them His session was followed by talk on “Beyond serendipity – The Science of Screening methods in Drug Discovery” by **Prof., A Muralidhar Rao**, Dean of Studies, St Mary’s College of Pharmacy, Secunderabad Telangana. 

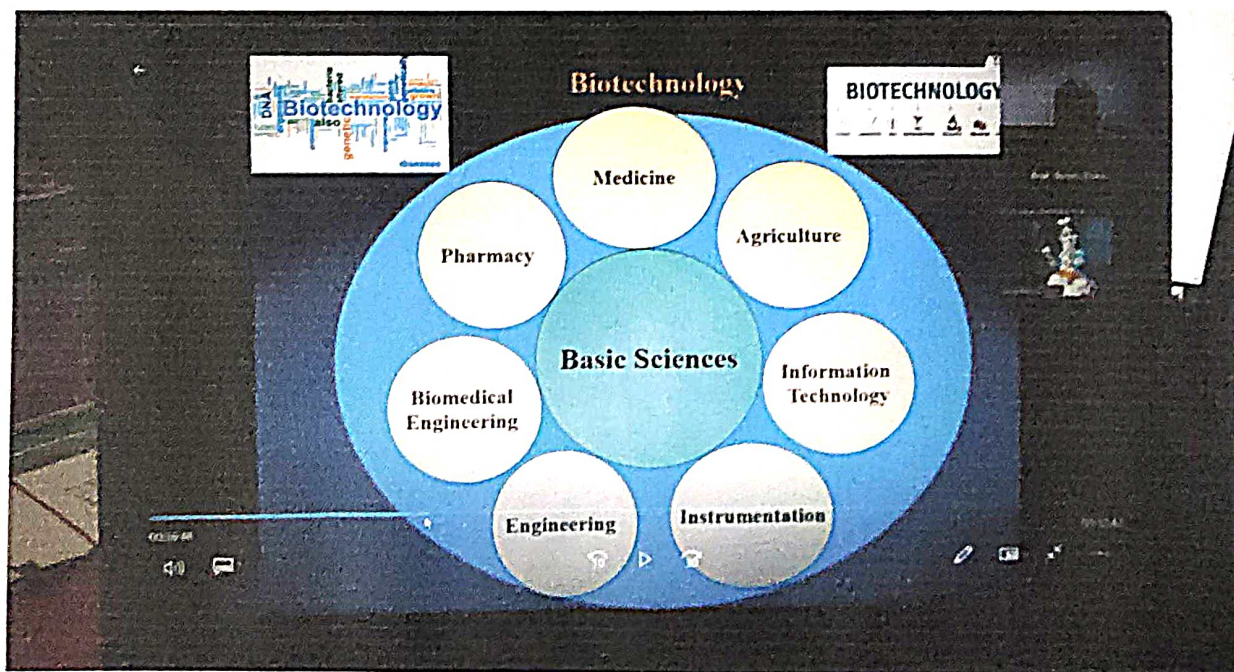
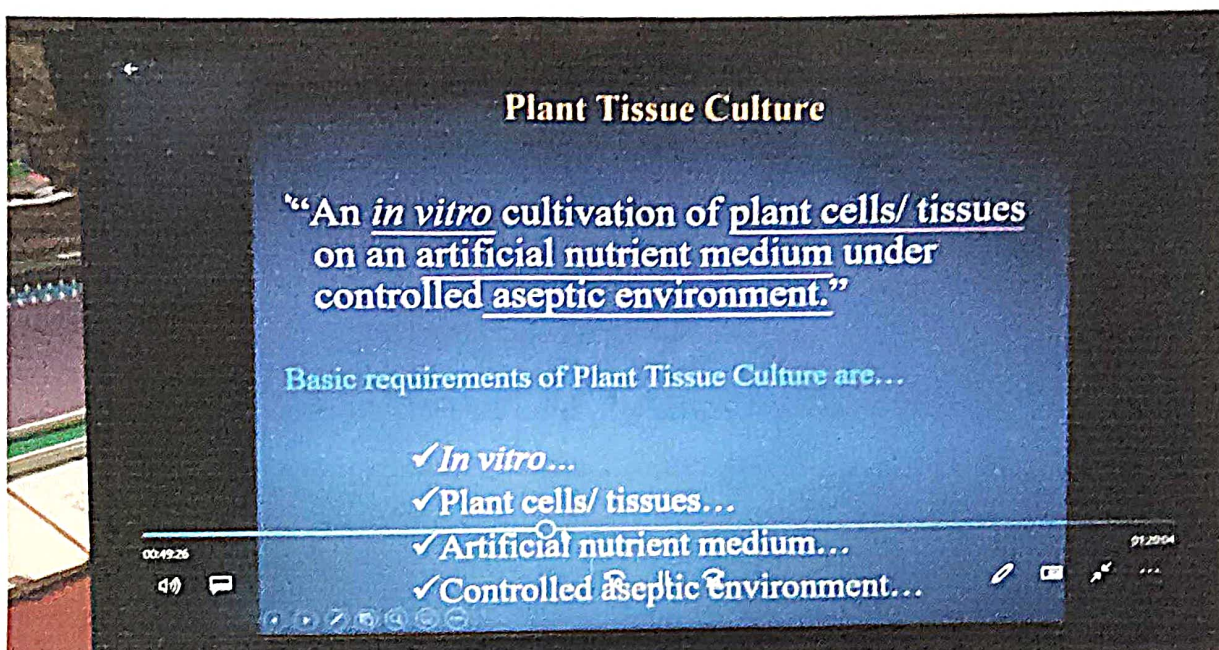
- Medicinal plants are the most exclusive source of life saving drugs for the majority of world's population.
- Over 80% of about 30,000 known natural products are of plant origin.
- About 8000 herbal remedies have been codified in Ayurveda, which is still in use.
- Bioactive compounds currently extracted from plants are used as food additives, pigments, dyes, fine chemicals, insecticides, cosmetics and perfumes.
- Number of plants as *Catharanthus roseus* (vinblastine, vincristine), *Artemisia annua* (artemisinin), *Camptotheca accuminata* (camptothecin), *Nothapodytes foetida*, *Taxus baccata* (taxol) etc. have been screened for anti-cancer, anti-malarial and other useful bioactive compounds.
